LOCAL GOVERNMENT

- Local governments provide critical services such as land use planning, drinking water and waste water, and public safety

- Need a comprehensive, coordinated and organized approach to provide services today and in the future

- What we looked for in our audit(s):
 - Emergency Management in alignment with legislative requirements
 - Emergency Management plans, programs and practices to respond to an emergency event in a timely manner and manage its consequences
 - Business Continuity management system with recovery procedures to resume critical operations in event of a disruption

MANY GOOD PRACTICES FOR OTHERS TO DRAW FROM, BUT RISKS WE HAVE SEEN INCLUDE...

- Lack strategic approaches to emergency management
- Lack organisation wide business continuity planning
- Focus primarily on the first three phases of emergency management
(mitigation & prevention, preparedness and response procedures)
with little emphasis on recovery strategies and resilience



WHAT WE HAVE FOUND SO FAR...

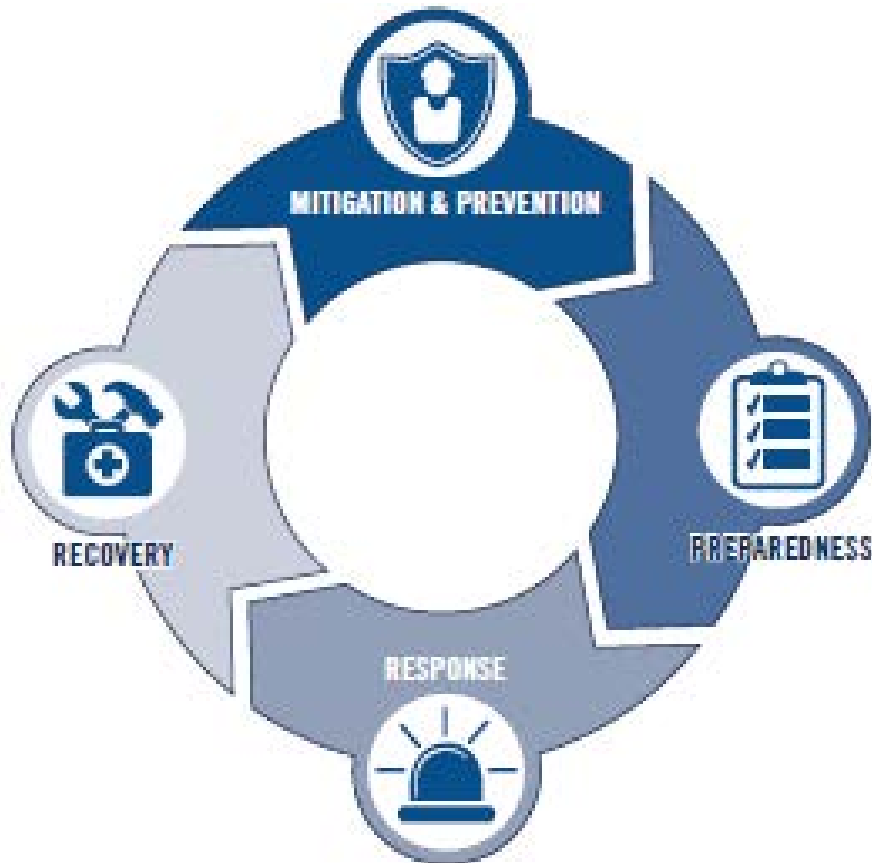
- Emergency management plans are often not reviewed and revised after initial development
- Emergency management plans often not tested, practiced or consistently implemented
- Do not recognize the impact of emergencies and recovery on vital systems such as IT services or communications
- Do not always have viable or accessible alternative water supplies available in the event of emergencies affecting drinking water services
